

Financial Aid for International Students

Christian Life College, Stockton, California

Financial aid is awarded on the basis of spiritual maturity, academic excellence, ministry potential and financial need. **Preference is given to applicants who show a high probability of returning to their home countries to minister.**

Financial aid is distributed in the form of **employment opportunity**. The college reserves a limited number of on-campus jobs for international students. These jobs are mainly in *janitorial services, maintenance, and non-specialized fields*. Once in a while, there is a job available, which requires computer skills, secretarial skills, etc.

The student who applies for an employment opportunity may commit himself to work a maximum of twenty (20) hours per week during the semester and up to forty (40) hours per week during the summer. Minimum wage is guaranteed. If a student's work is unsatisfactory or his GPA drops below 2.0, his employment opportunity may not be renewed.

A single student who pays the required amount down and works five hundred and forty (540) hours will be able to earn enough to meet his/her school bill. (The college should be called for the current down payment required.) ***This does not include the cost of books and any other expenses.*** Since the income from on-campus employment is not sufficient to meet family living expenses, a married student will need other sources of income, if he/she intends to bring his/her family.
